

Our Process

Our work is generally a 2-day process (weather, square footage, and opted services dependent).

<u>Day 1</u>

Paver Sealing is very similar to painting, 99% of our work is done by properly prepping the surface to accept the sealant. On the first day of our arrival, we start with any problem areas that were opted for repair at the time of the quote. After all quoted repairs are made, we then start the general pressure cleaning and stain removal process on the paver hardscape (if sealant stripping is required it will also be done at this time). After all cleaning is complete the paver hardscape will only be accessible by foot traffic for the next 48 hours (Driveways will be blocked off at this time).

<u>Day 2</u>

The start of day 2 is the cleanup of any loose debris left on the surface of your hardscape such as sand or leaves. Everything is meticulously swept and blown off. If you opted for joint sand replacement we then sweep in the sand type and color of your choosing, compact, then blow off any excess. After all loose debris are off the surface, we then apply the sealant chosen at the quoting process. The thickness of the coating is based on substrate composition, paver porosity, and type of sealant. After the sealant is applied, it will be 2 hours until accessible by foot traffic and a full 24 hours until accessible by vehicular traffic.

Why Seal Your Pavers?

It is no secret that the harsh Florida climate takes an extensive toll on anything left outside, your paver hardscape is no exception to this. Between the intense UV, consistent precipitation, and a mixture of high humidity with warm temperatures; your paver hardscape is susceptible a to lesser-than-average life span. These factors can cause your pavers to fade, grow mold/mildew, and also cause joint sand erosion which causes paver shifting. Sealing your paver hardscape not only prevents the common issues previously listed but can also prevent future staining as well. Some sealants can even provide an enhancement in color to your pavers giving them a "wet-look." It is important to keep a peace of mind, that is why we only use the best sealants available on the market; which we have tested and proven to provide years of dependability in protection and beauty.
